

The Harvey Morey Memorial Bible School Scholarship

West Side Presbyterian Church

This scholarship is established in memory of Harvey L. Morey (1932-1999). He was active at West Side Presbyterian Church as a Sunday school teacher, deacon, elder and, most especially will long be remembered for his service to the Missions Committee and his devotion to Jesus Christ and His Word. It was a special joy in his life to help people who desired a Bible school education. Harvey believed every person should experience a year of Bible courses before heading into any career in order to gain a solid Christian worldview before entering college or the working world. He believed the same applied to any person seeking a new direction in his/her life. To help make this dream of Harvey's possible, his family has created this special scholarship fund.

The scholarship is available to anyone in one of the following categories: (1) any member of West Side Presbyterian Church regardless of age, or (2) a young person currently active in the youth program at West Side, or (3) a missionary, or child of a missionary, currently on the missions funding guide.

Funding will come from an endowment of \$30,000 from the estate of Harvey Morey. The principal amount will be invested and the income used for scholarship awards. An additional \$2000 from the estate will be used for the first scholarships, until income is accumulated. Each scholarship award will be \$1000. The amount may be increased if funds are available. The check will be sent directly to the school, one-half per semester, or one-third per quarter.

Students attending short-term Bible Schools such as Ecola or Capernway are eligible, as are schools with a strong emphasis on Bible curriculum. A one-year Bible post-graduate study is also eligible. The scholarship may be renewed for a second academic year if the recipient demonstrates spiritual growth and a continued desire for Bible training. However, first-year applicants will be given priority consideration.

The Christian Education Department of West Side Presbyterian Church shall administer the scholarship. The Stewardship and Finance Department's Investment Committee shall establish the investment policy and oversee the financial position of the Scholarship Fund. The Scholarship Committee will receive requests, conduct interviews when possible, check references and recommend recipients.

It is the goal to award one new scholarship each year, but the Christian Education Department may choose not to grant an award in some years, or more than one award in other years, as funds allow. Application is by simple form, with the deadline for application set by the Scholarship Committee.

Selection shall be made according to the following criteria in this order of priority:

1. Personal testimony and public witness
2. Reason for the desire for a Bible school education
3. Financial need
4. First year applicant
5. Academic record

In the unlikely event of the dissolution of West Side Presbyterian Church, this endowment and any accumulated earnings shall be divided equally between **Frontiers** (a church-planting mission to Muslim peoples) and **East Gates Ministries** (an equipping ministry to the church of Christ in China). In the event a portion, or all, of the congregations of West Side Presbyterian Church should sever its relationship with the Presbytery of Seattle or the Presbyterian Church (USA) this endowment and any accumulated earnings shall remain with the majority group of the congregation.
